Looking for somewhere to fly? Swindon Model Aero Club fly from two sites:

- 1) SMAC fly on the huge expanse of Wroughton Airfield with its acres of grass and tarmac runways. It is one of the best sites in the country and possibly Europe, the excellent facilities provide for helicopters, fixed wing and silent flight on three separate sites on the airfield.
- 2) SMAC also fly off grass which measures 200ft x 200ft square, this also offers a huge expanse of flying area, so it is suitable for supervised novice as well as for the expert.

Currently, the airfield is open for model flying seven days a week, **subject to availability**. Formal training for beginners and those wishing to obtain their BMFA "A" and "B" achievement scheme ratings is available throughout the summer. Help is available at other times of flying, weather permitting.

Club owned dual controlled trainer is available for use for familiarisation and tuition. These include a helicopter, silent flight and power models. Help can be arranged for training and guidance.

A good relationship is enjoyed with the airfield owners (the Science Museum). To earn our tenure and continue this relationship, it is now part of the constitution that we actively support and help them by providing our services whenever they have a need for us. This may be directing traffic, selling programmes or providing a security service, by policing the hangars.
